



Woodford Remembers



William Neal

Died 9 May 1915

Family

Little can be found about William Neal. Loss of some of the Northamptonshire Regimental records makes it difficult to ascertain which of the four William Neal's born in Woodford in the appropriate time frame during the latter part of the 19th century is correct person.

It is likely that due to his low regimental number William had signed up early on and as he enlisted in Northampton he could well have been no longer a Woodford resident. This is however supposition.

Army Service

William enlisted with the Northamptonshire Regiment (2nd Battalion) and his regimental service number was 8831. He enlisted in Northampton giving his birthplace as Woodford. He fought in the Battle of Aubers Ridge on 9th May 1915 and was listed as being "killed in action."

He is listed on panel 07 of the Ploegsteert Memorial
